USAFE-AFAFRICA ECONOMIC IMPACT ANALYSIS 2019



In FY2019, the total economic impact of USAFE-AFAFRICA installations and personnel was \$2,664 billion.

The \$2,664 billion total economic impact consists of three major components highlighted in this tri-fold:

- \$1.4B in local spending by USAFE-AFAFRICA and local national personnel for items such as rent, food, and entertainment.
- \$.8B in local spending by installations for goods and services to sustain mission operations.
- \$.5B attributed to 9,910 of secondary jobs created by private business in the local communities.

USAFE base communities consist of a diverse group of people; US military personnel, DoD civilians, host nation employees. In addition, there are 30,215 military and civilian dependents, some of which are included in the above numbers). They work in military units and supporting activities (e.g., dining facilities, recreation centers, commissaries, and base exchanges) as well as in non-military activities (e.g., banks, credit unions, and local vendors).

Each USAFE base puts money into the economy of its host community by spending on locally purchased materials, supplies, equipment, utilities, and service contracts. In addition to spending by official Air Force units, recreational and other supporting organizations also make purchases off base as do on-base vendors, banks, and many other official on-base activities.
