What?	How?
collection and delivery services	permitted for all types of goods, including non-commercial goods Collector must accept the ordered goods at door or window. It is not permitted for collectors to enter the premises.
Fishing Park	permitted
Car dealerships	Sale and repair permitted
drive-in cinema	permitted (in compliance with hygiene requirements, i.e. it is not permitted to get out of the car, no sale of food and beverages)
Car rental/car sharing	permitted
Car wash	permitted
Bakeries	permitted No consumption on site is allowed.
Bars	closed
Funerals	Burials are permitted within the immediate family circle.
Concrete processing plants	permitted
Company canteen	closed, Sale for take-away allowed, but not consumption on the spot (except hospital canteens)
Flower shops	permitted (max. 800 sqm sales area)
Blood donation appointments	permitted
Cafés	closed; street sales are permitted
Campsites	The operation of campsites for tourist purposes is prohibited. This applies to short-term and long-term campers. The use of these facilities without an overnight stay is also not permitted. Only the use of the campsite as a 1st residence is permitted.
copy shop	permitted
Ice cream parlors	closed; collection, delivery and collection service is permitted. Street trading permitted.
occupational/learning therapy	permitted
Family Holiday Resorts	closed
holiday homes	It is prohibited to make them available for tourist purposes.
Podiatry	permitted

nursery	permitted
Golf courses	permitted (in compliance with hygiene requirements and minimum distance)
Church service in car cinema format	permitted (in compliance with hygiene requirements, i.e. it is not permitted to get out of the car)
Wedding	Civil weddings are permitted.
Hearing Care Professionals	permitted
Hotels	Operation for tourist purposes is prohibited.
Dog walker	permitted
Dog salon	permitted
Dog school	permitted
Snacks	permitted, no consumption on the spot
Youth Hostel	closed
Kiosks (especially with drinks, snacks, newspaper sales and post offices)	permitted
Beauty salon	closed
Agriculture	permitted
Truck wash plant	permitted
Lottery ticket office (in connection with the sale of newspapers)	permitted because of newspaper sales (the focus of the offer is decisive)
Malls / outlet center	(subject to compliance with hygiene requirements, in particular minimum distance, control of access, for example by means of access controls; these requirements apply regardless of whether the building complex is closed or a fenced-off area in the open air). Individual shops whose range of goods is not among the permissible exceptions may not provide more than 800 square metres of sales space.
Massage parlor	closed. Medical massages are allowed
Furniture collection service	allowed, since pick-up service
Music schools	closed
Nail-Studio	closed
Orthopaedic shoemaker, orthopaedic technician	permitted
Parcel acceptance- issuing office	Analogue mailroom, but no other sale of goods
Personal trainer	permitted, but only with 1:1 support
Pawnshops	permitted (provided the sales area does not exceed 800 square metres)
Physiotherapy	permitted
Travel agency	permitted (provided the sales area does not exceed 800 square metres)
Bicycle trade and repair shop	permitted

Medical supply store	permitted
Key services	permitted
Cable car	closed
Sunbeds	closed
marinas	permitted
Dance School	closed
Tattoo Studios	closed
Taxis	permitted
Tennis (popular sport)	outdoor permitted
retail outlets	irrespective of the assortment of goods, provided that the sales area on which goods are offered does not exceed 800 square metres. The sales area is decisive here, not the total size of the store. Larger shops can therefore separate part of their space.
