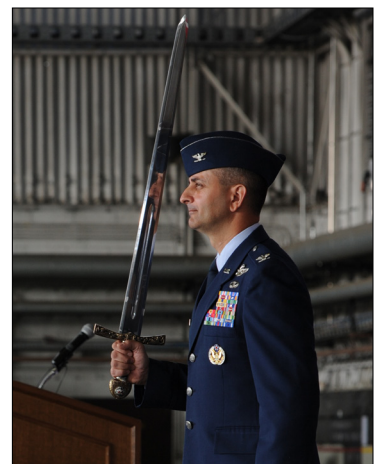
More than 400 people attended the event, to include Spangdahlem Airmen, families and local community leaders.
