OFFICIAL PASSPORT CHEAT SHEET

FIRST U.S. PASSPORT OF ANY KIND (Tourist or Official) OR ISSUED WHILE STILL A MINOR (15 and under)

- Typed Application (DS-11) Make sure parents information typed on the application matches what is on the birth certificate. Parent's birth dates **must** be included.
- Tasking Letter
- Original Birth Certificate or Naturalization Certificate
- Applicant Military ID
- Photo (must have been taken in the last 6 months)

ALREADY HAS A PASSPORT (Tourist or Official)

- Typed Application (DS-82) previously issued passport (official or tourist) number should be annotated on the application
- Tasking Letter
- All Previously issued passport
- Applicant Military ID
- Photo (must be taken in the last 6 months) Eye glasses are to be taken off for photo
- If your name has changed from what is indicated on your Birth Certificate or previously issued passport then documentation showing the reason for the name change (example marriage license, divorcee decree)
- ➤ If you have ever has a passport before and it has been lost or stolen make sure you also bring in a DS-64 (Lost or Stolen Passport form) If this form is submitted you must accompany it with the DS-11 application not the DS-64 (renewal).
